

SECTION 115 PENALTIES

115.01 GENERAL RULE.

Any person who violates a provision of this Code is guilty of a misdemeanor. Each act of violation and every day on which a violation occurs or continues is a separate violation.

115.03 EXCEPTIONS.

Where a provision of this Code or a statute adopted by reference therein sets a lesser penalty or a different period constituting a violation than set in subsection 115.01, such Code provision shall prevail.

115.05 APPLICABILITY.

It is the intention of the Council that the penalty provided by this Section or any other Section of this Code applies to an amendment of any Section of this Code whether or not such penalty is re-enacted in the amendatory ordinance unless otherwise provided in the amendatory ordinance.

115.07 FAILURE OF OFFICERS TO PERFORM DUTIES.

The penalty imposed by this Section does not apply to the failure of an officer or employee of the City to perform a duty imposed by this Code unless a penalty is specifically provided for such failure.

115.09 MISDEMEANOR DEFINED.

For purposes of this Code, the term "misdemeanor" means a penal offense or crime which is punishable by a fine of not more than \$300 or imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both.

115.11 PETTY MISDEMEANOR DEFINED.

For purposes of this Code, the term "petty misdemeanor" means a penal offense which is punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00.
