

## **SECTION 1206 BIRD SCARE GUN REGULATION**

### 1206.01 LIMITATION OF USE.

No person shall use, operate or permit the use or operation of machines used by farmers to keep animals and birds out of their fields, commonly known as "squawkers", "bird scare guns", or "pop guns":

- A. Before the hours of 7:30 A.M. or after the hour of 6:30 P.M. on any day; or
- B. Within a distance of 500 feet from any residential or commercial building.

### 1206.03 DIRECTION.

All "bird scare guns" shall be situated so as not to point or be directed toward any commercial or residential structure and shall be so positioned to cause the least amount of sound to affect adjacent properties.

### 1206.05 MINIMUM DISTANCE.

All "bird scare guns" shall be separated from other bird scare guns by a minimum distance of 500 feet.

### 1206.07 NON-USE AREA.

No "bird scare guns" shall be operated on any lands lying North and East of River Drive South in the City of Wabasha.

### 1206.09 PENALTY.

Any person who violates any provision of this Section is guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall upon conviction be subject to a fine of not more than \$200.
