

SECTION 735 CURFEW ORDINANCE

735.01 CURFEW IMPOSED.

No person 17 years of age or under, except as provided in Subsection 735.02, shall be on any public street or alley or in any park or other public grounds or building, place of amusement, entertainment or refreshment, vacant lot, or any other unsupervised place, or any private premises other than upon where his or her usual place of residence is located, without the knowledge, consent and approval of the owner or person in charge of or responsible for said private property in the City of Wabasha during the hours and periods of time as hereinafter established.

- Subd. 1. Between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. on the following day on every Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday night between Labor Day of each year, exclusive of Labor Day, and the 1st day of June of each year, exclusive of the 1st day of June of each year.
- Subd. 2. Between the hours of 12:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. of the following day on every Friday and Saturday night and the day before a nationally recognized holiday, between Labor Day of each year, exclusive of Labor Day, and the 1st day of June of each year, exclusive of the 1st day of June of each year.
- Subd. 3. Between the hours of 12:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. of the following day on every Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday night during the period of time between the 1st day of June of each year, including said day, and Labor Day of each year, including said day.

735.02 EXCEPTIONS.

Restrictions of Subsection 735.01 do not apply when the person 17 years of age or younger:

- Subd. 1. Is accompanied by the minor's parent, guardian or other person having the minor's lawful care, custody and control;
- Subd. 2. Is returning home by a direct route from and within 30 minutes after, a school activity or an activity of a religious or other voluntary association when prior notice of the activity and its place and probable time of termination has been given to the Police Department by an adult person authorized by the school or the religious or voluntary association to do so;

Subd. 3. Is carrying a certified card of employment and is on his way to or from his or her place of employment;

Subd. 4. Is upon an emergency errand or other legitimate business directed by the person's parent, guardian or other adult having the lawful custody of the person.

735.03 RESPONSIBILITY OF PARENT.

No parent, guardian or other adult having custody and control of a minor 17 years of age or under shall knowingly permit the minor to violate the provisions of this Section.

735.07 PENALTIES.

Any person 17 years of age or under on any street or other place in violation of this Section shall be ordered to go home immediately. After investigation, if responsible City authorities determine that court action should be initiated, the person 17 years of age or under shall be dealt with in accordance with Juvenile Court law and procedure. Any such person who is convicted of a violation of this Section after the case has been referred for prosecution in the trial court under Minnesota Statute Section 260.15 and any person who is convicted of a violation of any provision of this Section is guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of not to exceed \$200.
