

SECTION 410 CURBSIDE RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING

410.01 LICENSE REQUIREMENT.

No person shall engage in curbside hauling of recyclable material from any residential premises other than their home domicile in the City of Wabasha unless that person holds a valid license hereunder and also a valid garbage hauling license pursuant to Section 405 of the Wabasha City Code.

Subd. 1. The term of each license shall be from March 1 through the end of February of each year and there shall be no fee required for obtaining a license.

Subd. 2. The application for license or renewal of license shall contain a description of the types and makes of the motor vehicles used for collection, a schedule of the services to be made to the customers, the frequency of service to be rendered, and full information as to where and how the materials collected will be disposed of, and any other information the City of Wabasha shall require.

Subd. 3. Application for license hereunder shall be submitted to the City for review and recommendation. If the Council is satisfied that the public need, convenience and good order will be served thereby, it may grant one or more licenses pursuant to this Section.

410.03 SEPARATION REQUIRED.

All recyclable items set out for disposal by the owner or occupant of every residence within the City shall be set out for disposal so that the following matters are separated:

- A. Newsprint (Non-glossy print)
- B. Rinsed glass bottles and other glass containers without rings or caps
- C. Aluminum and tin cans
- D. Plastic containers

410.05 COLLECTION.

Collection of separated materials shall be at least once per month and shall be set out for disposal in separate containers at curbside. The license holder hereunder may establish its own rules and regulations in addition to any of these requirements and any such rule shall be subject to prior approval by the City Council.

410.07 SCAVENGING OF RECYCLABLES.

Subd. 1. The ownership of recyclables as defined herein shall remain and be vested in the person or persons who or which collected and stored the recyclables until collected by a hauler authorized by the City to collect recyclables and serving such person or persons at which time such ownership shall vest in such hauler.

Subd. 2. No person shall remove, take or collect recyclables owned by any other person, except, however, a hauler authorized by the City to collect recyclables and serving such owner as provided in this section. A violation of this Section shall constitute a petty misdemeanor subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00.

410.09 RESIDENTIAL APPLICATION.

This Section shall apply only to curbside residential recycling and pickup of residential recycled materials.
