The Wabasha City Pool is switching to online registration this year. You will use this website to purchase swimming lessons, pool parties, all types of pool passes, and apply for the free pool passes. The Wabasha Kellogg Area Community Foundation is providing free passes to qualifying students through 8th grade and allowing them to swim for FREE all summer long. This applies to any student enrolled in Wabasha Kellogg School, St. Felix School, or SAIL and has an address within our district area. AGE GUIDELINE FOR SWIMMING LESSONS

Parent/Child Class 6 months - 3 years
(designed for children to build water confidence, safety skills, and bonding, parents will get in the water)

Water Tots Class 3-4 years
(designed to learn basic skills like submersions, breath control, and floating through fun, structured activities, parents can get in the water)

Level 1 Water Exploration 5-6 years

Level 2 Primary Skills 6-7 years

Level 3 Stroke Readiness 8 years

Level 4 Stroke Development 9 years

Level 5 Stroke Refining 10 years

Level 6 Proficiency 11 years

Lifeguard Training 15+ years

** All instructors are trained through the Red Cross program and are qualified to teach their classes. If you have any concerns about your child's physical condition, please consult your physician before enrollment. If our lifeguards determine that your child is not placed in the appropriate class, they, along with the pool director, will discuss alternative placement options with you to ensure your child is in the best-suited class.

Pool Closure Policies & Information

This information will be posted on the Wabasha City Pool Facebook page, and correspondence will go out via text message if you sign up for notifications through <https://wabashamn.myrec.com>

- Pool closes when the outdoor temperature falls under 65 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Pool closes when lightning is sighted, or weather is threatening. Weather is then assessed at 2-hour intervals.
- Pool closes if there is need for emergency repairs or maintenance.
- If a condition that is not safe is found, the pool will close until the situation is corrected.
- Pool is subject to close for the remainder of a scheduled open swim when there are fewer than 5 people in the pool.
